

Dog AM and PM Enrichment Schedule

Enrichment items that require freezing can be prepped on any day and placed in the enrichment freezer. Please mark each dog's enrichment log after the item is given. Take note of any dogs that have special diets or restrictions, as well as avoiding "staff only", wall kennels, and quarantined areas.

During AM cleanings, all eligible dogs will receive a peanut butter rubber toy.

Scheduled Day	Enrichment Activity
Monday	Treat Dispensing Toy – Take a treat dispensing toy, such as a Kong Wobbler, and place a handful of "K9 i/d" kibble inside.
Tuesday	Calming Scent – Spray 1-2 spritzes of Adaptil onto a soft toy (or a hard toy if the dog is not allowed soft toys).
Wednesday	Drive By Treats – Toss a few treats or pieces of kibble into each dog's kennel by throwing them underneath the door.
Thursday	Treat Dispensing Toy – Take a treat dispensing toy, such as a Kong Wobbler, and place a handful of "K9 i/d" kibble inside.
Friday	Paper Bag – Place a few dog treats or a small handful of "K9 i/d" kibble in a crumpled paper bag.
Saturday	Peanut Butter Rubber Toy – Take a Kong, rubber toy, or hard toy and smear peanut butter on/in it. Freeze them for a longer lasting treat!
Sunday	Muffin Tins – Take a muffin tin and spread peanut butter in each cup. Freeze them for a longer lasting treat!
