

Dog holding cleaning

(**DO NOT** clean Staff-Only, Bite Quarantine, and Wall-kennel dogs)

- **Spot cleaning**

- Using the guillotine door (Bone shaped handle) close the dog on one side, remove the carabiner, and start on the side the dog is not on.
- Use the poop scooper to scoop poop and flush it down in the toilet.
- Always remove soiled blankets, food bowls, and rubber Kongs. Water buckets can be set aside for re-use if not soiled. (**Bowls and Kongs can be set by the sink**)
- Use a Rescue pump sprayer to spray soiled areas. Walls, doors, and ground. (**If there is poop stuck you can let sanitizer sit for 5 minutes to get it up easier.**)
- After spraying you will wipe down with a dog hand towel.
- Leave the backside empty after cleaning & for the front side spread a blanket on the ground and place a bucket of fresh water in the back corner of the kennel where the drain is.
- Place carabiner back & leave the guillotine door open after cleaning both sides.

- **Deep cleaning “NC” kennels**

- Close guillotine door if open.
- Remove all dirty items completely and scoop poop with a poop scooper.
- Using the hose and foamer, spray the walls; doors; and the ground of the front and back side of the kennel.
- Use the bristle scrub brush to scrub the kennel completely.
- Let rescue disinfectant sit for **10mins** after scrubbing.
- Rinse the kennel with the hose, squeegee the ground, and then dry off with a dog hand towel.
- Erase **NC**.

- **After cleaning**

- Sweeping & Mopping (**Mop bucket: 8oz of rescue to 128oz of water. Get from the blue barrel in bulk storage**)
- Dishes: Hand wash, place in the dishwasher with dishwasher detergent, and then press start. Switch sign to “Clean”.
- Rubber Kongs cleaning: Must be completely free of food before going into the dishwasher and always must be placed on the top rack of the dishwasher. (**Clean dry Kongs can be placed in bulk storage**)
